Position Overview:

Working with a team of health professionals in an inter-professional collaborative model, under the direction and supervision of a Registered Physician, and in accordance with the College of Physicians and Surgeons of Ontario's policy on delegation, the Physician Assistant (PA) provides medical care to patients based on mutually agreed upon guidelines.

Roles and Responsibilities:

When/as directed by a Registered Physician, the PA will within the existing clinical space and sometimes beyond its boundaries:

- Perform complete clinical assessment of patients and formulate treatment plans
- Conduct physical assessments and interpret findings
- Utilize primary and secondary assessment results to formulate a differential diagnosis and determine if further clinical investigations are required

- Order and complete preliminary interpretation of diagnostic tests
- Perform agreed upon diagnostic procedures
- Implement interventions or procedures as necessary
- Monitor patient progress and response to treatment

Communication:

When/as directed by a Registered Physician, the PA will within the existing clinical space and sometimes beyond its boundaries:

- Communicate patient diagnosis to the patient.
- Provide relevant information and explanations, including a proposed treatment plan, to the supervising physician and seek further direction where appropriate.
- Provide education to patients, families and other health providers as appropriate to the clinical setting. Communicate with other members of the health care team and/or other specialists or health care agencies, both orally, in writing and electronically.
- Maintain clear, accurate and appropriate records of the patient encounter and management plan.

Judgement/Initiative/Responsibilities:

- Uses resources effectively and efficiently
- Participates as a member of the interdisciplinary team
- Supports the vision, mission and values of the Marathon Family Health Team
- Participates in the creation of medical directives, continuous quality improvement, risk management and safety initiatives
