The ideal candidate will have strong diagnostic abilities, manage acute and chronic conditions, and be committed to health promotion and education.

- Facilitation of the Marathon Family Health Team urgent care clinic, providing appointments for, but not limited to; episodic illnesses and other health care concerns presenting within the RN EC Scope of Practice.
- Provide assistance and program development for the prevention and management of chronic disease(s).
- Develop and deliver evidence-based intervention and treatment plans for priority population groups identified in the Family Health Team Strategic Plan, including adolescents, individuals experiencing mental health and/or addiction challenges, individuals with chronic conditions, aging populations, and vulnerable populations.
