JOB SUMMARY

The RN will work collaboratively with physicians, the nurse practitioner, the physician assistant, and allied health professionals to provide comprehensive, patient-centred care across the lifespan. This includes chronic disease management, health promotion, disease prevention, acute episodic care, care coordination, health education, clinical procedures, and participation in quality improvement initiatives.

- Provide direct patient care including assessments, immunizations, wound care, and injections.
- Facilitate independent nursing clinics (e.g., BP, foot care, pap tests, medication follow-ups).
- Support chronic disease management and health promotion activities.
- Document care and maintain accurate EMR records.
- Educate patients on medications, conditions, and preventive health.
- Triage patient concerns and provide telephone support within scope.
- Collaborate with physicians, NPs, and allied health professionals.
- Maintain infection control standards and manage clinical supplies.
- Assist with clinical procedures and specimen collection.
- Contribute to quality improvement and clinic operations.
